4. Read Isaiah 40: 3-5.

- What do these verses say about how we, as the church, can address issues of exile experienced by those with mental health issues?
- What might these efforts look like at Hope?

5. Read Matthew 5:3.

- o In what ways could someone be "poor in spirit"?
- How does this verse help us understand there is no shame in seeking help for mental illness?
