3. Read Luke 3:7-9.

- How do you think the crowd responded to John the Baptist's rebuke "You brood of snakes!"?
- What do we learn from these verses about complacency in our relationship with God and His expectations for how we are to live?

4. Read Luke 3:10-14.

- How do you think the crowd responded to John the Baptist's explanations when they asked, "What should we do?"
- Which of his responses about handling our possessions resonates most with you? Why?

5. Read Luke 12:13-15.

- In what ways does Jesus' warning to "Guard against every kind of greed." stand in sharp contrast to Forbes' statement, "The one who dies with the most toys wins."?
- How do you think Jesus' implication was received that the individual's concern about inheritance was motivated by greed rather than fairness?
 - Why does greed often surface when dealing with issues of inheritance?
