- Why is the concept of the poor inheriting the kingdom of God difficult for James' contemporaries - and for us - to grasp?

### 5. Read James 2:8-9, Deuteronomy 10:17-19.

- Why might James' call to "Love your neighbor as yourself" be easier said than done?
- In what ways does the Deuteronomy text resonate with issues of favoritism and discrimination today?
