Texts Referenced (NLT): James 4:6-12, Matthew 7:1-5, Philippians 2:2-8

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?

3. Read James 4:6-10.

- What do these verses tell us about the process of possessing humility?
- How does James suggest that being humble requires acknowledging hard truths about ourselves?

4. Read James 4:11-12, Matthew 7:1-5.

- What do we learn from these passages about the flip side of humility judging others?
- Why are we so quick to judge others, even as we strive to be humble in God's eyes?

5. Read Philippians 2:2-8.

- Which examples of Jesus' humility resonate most with your understanding of what it means to be humble?
- How do these examples of spiritual humility connect with your understanding of a servant-leader in secular contexts (e.g., business, education, politics)?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
