"Benedictus" - #2 in the series Heaven and Nature Sing

Texts (NLT): Luke 1: 67-79, Jeremiah 29:11

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- **2.** This week's text contains *The Benedictus,* a song offered by Zechariah that describes a prophetic destiny he believes God has chosen for his infant son, who would become known as John the Baptist.
 - Have you ever experienced a sense of destiny something you believe you were meant to do?
 - What did you learn about yourself and others as a result of your experience with destiny?

3. Read Luke 1:67-71.

Consider the examples of God's relationship to Israel in this portion of Zechariah's song.

- How do these verses help us think about the idea that God has a universal plan and purpose?
- In what ways does understanding God's universal plan help us accept that he also has an individual plan for us?

4. Read Luke 1:76-79.

 What can we learn from these verses about a prophetic kind of destiny vs. one that comes from someone's desire to control the destiny of another? (Consider the excerpt from The Dead Poets' Society movie in which Neil's father has his son's destiny mapped out for him.)

5. Read Jeremiah 29:11.

- In what ways does this verse affirm your thinking about your own destiny?
- How can we demonstrate our belief in the idea of God's universal and personal plan for us through the ministries of Hope?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
