Text: Romans 12:9-18 (NLT)

 - Where do you see the need for peace in each?



3. **Read Romans 12: 9-13.**
 - Which of the ways Paul lists to show love—to live peaceably—resonates most with you? Why?
 - Which poses more of a challenge? Why?
4. **Read Romans 12: 14-16.**
 - What allows us to rejoice with those “who are happy and weep with those who weep”?
 - In what ways does a know-it-all attitude—ours or someone else’s—interfere with our ability to live peaceably?
5. **Read Romans 12: 17-18.**
 - How do you respond to the idea of being transparent—so that everyone can see that you are honorable—as a way to live peaceably?
 - Why do there seem to be so many issues around transparency, or lack of it, today?
6. How can we pray for you?
