Texts (NIV): Isaiah 10:1-2, Zechariah 7:9-10, Luke 11:39-42

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. In the Disney animated film version of *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*, Quasimodo, suffers extreme humiliation and violence because of his lower social status and physical disability.
 - Why does mistreatment of the vulnerable seem part of the human condition?
 - Why is it difficult to stand up to this kind of injustice?
- 3. Consider the scene when Esmerelda rushes to defend Quasimodo who has been shackled in the midst of an angry crowd.
 - What does she demonstrate about the characteristics of restorative justice compassion, action, and calling out injustice?
 - What examples of compassion and action in confronting injustice in history or in real life have been influential or inspirational for you?
- 4. Read Isaiah 10:1-2, Zechariah 7: 9-10.
 - Why do some leaders seem intent on establishing "unjust laws" designed to discriminate against the vulnerable?
 - What are some legal and social injustices we currently see in our community? In our country?
- 5. Read Luke 11:39-42.
 - What might be a modern interpretation of the metaphorical "cleaning the outside of the cup" but not the inside?
 - How does our sense of justice retributive or restorative influence how we think about community?
