

"Life and Mystery" - #1 in the series The Wild Goose: Exploring the Holy Spirit

Texts (NLT): Genesis 1: 1-2; John 14: 15-17; John 3:8

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Consider the following graphic depicting the Trinity, specifically the role of the Holy Spirit.



- What is your understanding of the work and role of the Holy Spirit?
- How do you respond to the early Celtic Christians adopting a wild goose, rather than a dove, as the symbol of the Holy Spirit because of its passionate, noisy, and courageous nature?

3. **Read Genesis 1:1-2.**

"Spirit" is the Hebrew feminine word "ruach," which means *breath or wind*, suggesting the Holy Spirit is a life-giver.

- Why do you think some languages include gendered designations?
- How do gendered languages—like Hebrew and Greek—limit our understanding of the Trinity's three "persons"?

4. Read John 14: 15-17.

- How does Jesus' use of "Advocate" help you understand the role of the Holy Spirit?
- Why might it be tough for "the world" to receive or recognize the Holy Spirit?

Read John 3:8.

- Is there a time when you were aware of the Holy Spirit's working in your life that was initially difficult to understand or even mysterious?
- How can we learn to take comfort in the unpredictability of the Holy Spirit?
