"Power and Gifts" - #2 in the series The Wild Goose: Exploring the Holy Spirit

Texts (NIV): Acts 2:1-4; 1 Corinthians 12:4-11; Romans 12:6-8

1. What stood out to you about the message?

- 2. Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other disciples the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to send an "advocate" to be with them forever marking the beginning of the Christian church's mission to the world.
 - How do you imagine they received or reacted to this promise?

3. Read Acts 2:1- 4.

The Holy Spirit's appearance to the Apostles could be described as extraordinary - even shocking.

- Why might God have chosen such a "wild" and unpredictable entrance into the faith of the Apostles and other disciples?
- Have you ever experienced the working of the Holy Spirit in an extraordinary or unexpected way?

4. Read I Corinthians 12:4-11.

The diversity of spiritual gifts Paul describes are not all-inclusive but are varied and distributed as the Spirit determines.

- Although spiritual gifts are not ranked in importance, why do some place greater importance on some than others?
- Have you ever felt you've been given a spiritual gift for a specific purpose?

5. **Read Romans 12: 6–8**.

Paul provides an additional perspective on spiritual gifts, guiding us <u>on how</u> to use the gifts we've been given.

- How do you understand the role of grace in the spiritual gifts we are given?
- Why might how we use our gifts be as important as the gifts themselves?
