- Why does Jesus mention the prospect of betrayal and estrangement within a family when warning about potential "cancel" experiences?

4. Read Matthew 19: 13–15.

- What can we learn from Jesus' interaction with the children considering Gen Z's sensitivity to cancel culture?
- Why do older generations tend to minimize the importance of the younger generation?
- **5.** Think about the Gen Z members of our congregation.
 - o In what ways do we offer comfort and support to them?
 - What might make it easier for us to connect with them?
