Text Referenced: Philippians 4:1-9 (NRSV)

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Consider the context for this portion of Paul's letter to the church at Philippi.
 - Paul is writing from his prison cell in Rome.
 - He responds to a matter of internal concern and offers advice as they navigate the theological and external challenges of being under Roman rule.
 - Are there other aspects of the Church at Philippi with which you are familiar?

3. Read Philippians 4: 1-3.

- Generally, what do we learn about Paul's relationship with these early Christians?
- Specifically, what are your thoughts about his response to the situation with Euodia and Syntyche?

4. Read Philippians 4: 4-7.

- How would/have you responded to being advised to rejoice, show gentleness, and not be anxious in a difficult situation?
- When have you experienced the "peace of God" that guards your heart and mind as a result of praying about "everything"?

5. Read Philippians 4: 8-9.

- What helps us appreciate the positive aspects of our faith when we're in a difficult situation?
- How has recognizing these blessings helped you navigate challenging times?
