Texts Referenced (NIV): Mark 12:28-34, Leviticus 19:18, Romans 13: 8-10

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Good and not-so-good neighbors can have a significant impact on how we feel about where we live.
  - What memories or experiences do you have of a good neighbor?
  - o How have you navigated situations with a difficult neighbor?

## 3. Read Mark 12: 28-31, Leviticus 19:18.

"Love your neighbor as yourself." is the second part of Jesus' answer to the local teacher's question about the greatest of God's commandments.

- How do you respond to the idea that neighbors are people we know <u>and</u> don't know - that wherever we are, we have neighbors?
- o How does love for self affect the ways we love our neighbors?

## 4. Read Mark 12: 32-34.

- What does the interaction between Jesus and the local teacher show us about how we should relate to others as neighbors?
- How is the practice of sacrifice and burnt offerings important to understanding why loving your neighbor as yourself is part of the greatest commandment?

#### 5. Read Romans 13: 8-10.

According to Paul, love is the fulfillment of the law - the achievement of something desired.

- Why are his words significant in light of his life experience?
- What does or can loving our neighbors look like at Hope?
