 - Which do you find most challenging?
 - Why do you think Jesus included "with all your mind" not mentioned in the Deuteronomy text?
- 4. Read Mark 12: 32-34, Colossians 3:17.
 - What can we learn from the final exchange between Jesus and the teacher who questioned Him about the first great commandment?
 - As you consider everything you do even the activities of everyday living what does it mean to do them "in the name of Jesus"?
