Texts Referenced (NIV and MSG): Matthew 5:3-12, 2 Corinthians 5:16-17

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?

3. Read Matthew 5: 3-10.

For many, Jesus' statements about what it means to be blessed go against conventional wisdom.

- Which of these beatitudes seems particularly counterintuitive to you?
- Have you ever been blessed by being in a very difficult situation? What happened?

4. Read Matthew 5:11-12.

Jesus acknowledges situations where others actively oppose us or attack our character.

- Has this ever happened to you, and if so, did any good a blessing come from it?
- How do situations like this affect how we think about our identity?

5. Read 2 Corinthians 5: 16-17.

- Why might Paul and others initially have judged Jesus from a worldly point of view?
- How can we learn to view others from a perspective of simplicity, hopefulness, humility, and compassion?
