Silence - #1 in the series: Ghosted - What To Do When God Seems Silent

Texts Referenced (NIV): Psalm 28: 1-2; Psalm 102: 1-2; Lamentations 3: 22-24

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Consider the current meaning of the word ghosted: *having all contact and communication cut off abruptly and without explanation.* 
  - Have you ever been ghosted by someone you thought was a friend?
  - o In what ways can ghosting be harmful to the ghoster as well as the ghosted?

## 3. Read Psalm 28: 1-2.

David pleads for God to hear and respond to him.

- What do we learn about David's relationship with God and his emotional state?
- Have you ever felt God was silent or absent despite your best efforts? What was that experience like?

#### 4. Read Psalm 102: 1-2.

- What do these verses suggest about the petitioner's mindset and the issue of timing - ours and God's - when we pray?
- Consider the opportunities God's silence offers us while we wait: introspection, deconstruction (examination), and preparation (for what's to come).
  - What opportunities have you realized maybe in hindsight while waiting for God's response to your prayer(s)?

### 5. Read Lamentations 3: 22-24.

While waiting for God's response may be difficult, these verses assure us He is never absent.

- How have you been reminded of God's presence, even during a time of His silence?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
