Presence - #3 in the series: Ghosted - What To Do When God Seems Silent

Texts Referenced (NIV): Deuteronomy 31: 6-8, Psalm 23: 4, Matthew 18:20

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. *Presence* suggests that someone is nearby or in close proximity. In a spiritual context, *God's presence* means He is actively near and involved.
 - Can you recall a time when God made his presence actively known to you?
 - How did His presence impact your experience in that situation?

3. Read Deuteronomy 31: 6-7.

Moses speaks directly, first to the Israelites and then to Joshua.

- What do you imagine the Israelites would have felt at this point in their journey?
- Why do you think it would have been necessary for the people to hear Moses' words for Joshua?

4. Read Deuteronomy 31: 8.

- Has God's presence ever impacted your sense of safety, direction, or purpose? In what ways?
- Has God ever used someone else as in the case of Moses- to reassure you of His presence?

5. Read Psalm 23: 4 and Matthew 18:20.

- Have you ever been in a situation or a season of life when you weren't sure God was present?
 - How were you able to navigate this experience? What happened?
- How do these verses remind us that God's presence often manifests in community?
- How can we at Hope intentionally manifest God's presence?
- 6. How can we pray for you?
