- 4. Which of the following questions are helpful to you in recalling the ways you've witnessed God in your life?
  - O How is God at work in my life?
  - o How has God answered prayer in my life?
  - How has the Holy Spirit guided me in my life?
  - **5.** Now consider these questions in helping organize how you might share your witness with someone else:
    - Who is Jesus to me?
    - Why do I follow Jesus?
    - What is so compelling about Jesus' story in my life?
    - What part of my story intersects with the story of Jesus?
    - Which of these aspects of your witness seems most exciting to share? Most challenging?
    - Why is the prospect of sharing our witness sometimes intimidating or fearful?
    - When have you been able to share your spiritual witness with someone? What happened?
