5. Re-read Romans 6:3-4.

Consider how baptism demonstrates that we have shared in Jesus' death and burial but also have a <u>New Life</u> in HIm.

- Why would this be a difficult concept for some to understand?
- How would you or have you explained your baptism experience to someone else?

6. Read Matthew 28:19-20.

- How does the sacrament of baptism deepen your understanding of what Jesus meant when he said, "Make disciples."?
