Baptize - #4 in the series: *Make Disciples*

Texts Referenced (NIV): Romans 6:3-4, Galatians 3:26-27, Matthew 28:19-20

1. What stood out to you about the message?
2. Consider how baptism is a sacrament - a ritual or outward sign of a gift given to us by God.
 - What images or memories do you have of your or someone else's baptism?
 - In what ways have these images or memories remained important to you?
3. **Read Romans 6:3-4.**
 - How does baptism demonstrate a relationship of Belonging to Jesus?
 - How might our relationships help us understand what it means to belong to Jesus?
4. **Read Galatians 3:26-27 and Romans 12:4-5.**
 - How does baptism extend our sense of Belonging to Others?
 - What does belonging to others in a community of faith look like?
5. **Re-read Romans 6:3-4.**

Consider how baptism demonstrates that we have shared in Jesus' death and burial but also have a New Life in Him.

 - Why would this be a difficult concept for some to understand?
 - How would you or have you explained your baptism experience to someone else?
6. **Read Matthew 28:19-20.**
 - How does the sacrament of baptism deepen your understanding of what Jesus meant when he said, "Make disciples."?
