Texts Referenced (NRSV): John 15:1-9, 16-17; Matthew 28:20

- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Think about a situation when you were aware of God's presence.

#### 3. Read John 15:1-8.

- Why might Jesus have chosen images of a vine, branches, fruit, and a gardener to illustrate the truths of the disciples' relationships - and ours - with Him?
- What is the "fruit" Jesus calls his disciples to bear?

#### 4. Read John 15:9-11.

Jesus repeatedly uses the word abide to describe the connection He desires with us.

- Given the Greek origin of abide (meno), which means to remain, what does abiding look like to you?
- What are some things that can keep us from abiding in Christ?

### 5. Read John 15:16-17; Matthew 28:20.

Consider the promise of God's answer to prayer and the reassurance of his presence.

- Can you recall when abiding in Jesus has resulted in answers to prayer?
- What can we learn from the ways Jesus demonstrated his earthly presence?
- 6. How have the following topics in this series, *Make Disciples*, helped you better understand what it means to <u>be</u> or <u>make</u> disciples?
  - Live Like a Disciple
  - Go!
  - Baptize
  - Be A Witness
  - Teach and Learn About Jesus
  - Trust in Jesus' Presence Always
