"Selflessness" - #1 in the series Open Hands: *Living as Generous People of God*

Scripture Texts (NRSV): Philippians 2:1-11,

Deuteronomy 15:7-11



- 1. What stood out to you about the message?
- 2. Consider the message's humorous example of riding roller coasters and how some people fearlessly fling their arms up in joyous abandon, while others hang on for dear life.
 - o How do you react to roller coaster rides?
 - What does this example suggest about why people react very differently in the same situation?
 - Why is it easier for some people to "let go" of their concerns or fears than others?

3. Read Philippians 2:1-4.

Paul urges the believers at Philippi to have the same mindset of unity and selflessness as Jesus.

- How do you respond to the idea that *selflessness is letting go of ego?*
- Is it possible to possess humility but maintain a healthy self-esteem in the service of Christ?
- O How is this quality of selflessness essential to unity?

4. Read Philippians 2:5-11.

- How does Paul's use of the Greek word for "exploited" harpagmos, meaning to grasp or clutch as a prize help us better understand Jesus' selflessness?
- O How do you respond to the idea that being selfless can mean letting go of abundance?
- Why is it important that Paul explains how God responded to His Son's ultimate act of selflessness?

5. Read Deuteronomy 15:7-11.

This passage offers a practical "blueprint" for what being selfless in the service of the Lord looks like.

- Which of these examples of selflessness resonates most with you?
- What can challenge our ability to be selfless in these ways?
- Have you ever been the recipient of someone's selfless decision or gesture? What was that experience like?
